These are the instructions for
unikatissima's Lace Knitter's Advent Calendar 2016

Enjoy!



The shawl you will knit this year is in length symmetrically patterned.

The pattern comprises amongst others net lace, lace leaf and lace diamond parts, a pattern repeat of 24 stitches which allows you to decide on the width of your shawl and in the middle a lengthening pattern* to lengthen the shawl to your liking.

Well, you'll see, just start and enjoy!

* On day 12 you will have knitted the first half of the pattern and thus know how long your shawl will be. Then you will learn more about the lengthening pattern and decide if you want to knit it.

Symbols & Abbreviations

st -	stitch	RS -	right side
* ... *	repeat	WS -	wrong side
2x (...)	repeat 2x instruction in parentheses		

If not stated otherwise purl (p) all stitches on the WS

- k - RS: knit
- yo - RS: yarn over
- skpo - RS: slip 1, knit 1, pass slipped stitch over or other left decrease
- k2tog - RS: knit 2 together or other right decrease
- s2kpo - centered double decrease -
RS: slip 2 stitches as if to k2tog, knit 1, pass both slipped stitches over or other centered 2 stitch decrease
- (s2kpo OR skpo) -
RS: if last repeat: skpo
otherwise: s2kpo
- E edge st - edge/selvedge stitch(es), use your favourite edge stitch(es) like e.g. *slip the edge stitches purlwise*

General information

Wrong side rows (WS)

All instructions show only the RS rows, purl (p) all stitches on the WS if not stated otherwise.

Garter stitch edging

If you choose to add a couple of stitches in garter stitch at the begin and end of the row (= knit every row) you may also want to add a couple of garter stitch rows at the begin and end of your shawl.

Cast-on

Cast-on NUMBER OF WANTED REPEATS X 24 + 3 + 2 X NUMBER OF WANTED EDGE STITCHES.

Example: you want to knit 3 repeats and 4 garter stitches on each side, then cast-on $3 \times 24 + 3 + 2 \times 4 = 83$ stitches.

Bind-off

I suggest to use a loose bind-off for your shawl, e.g. Jeny's surprisingly stretchy bind off (www.knitty.com/ISSUEfall09/FEATjssbo.php).

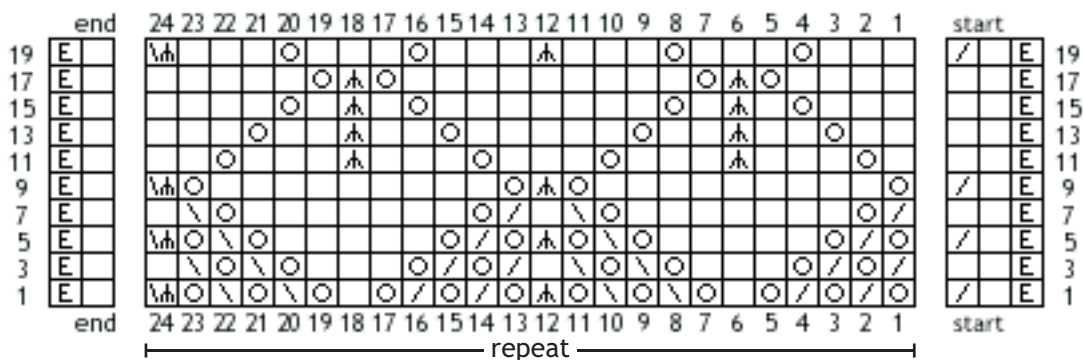
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Advent 2016 - day 1

the pattern shows only the right side rows

find the *number of stitches to cast-on, symbols & abbreviations* and how to knit stitches in the wrong side rows on page 2



- row 1: edge st, k, k2tog,
*yo, k2tog, yo, k2tog, yo, k, yo, skpo, yo, skpo, yo, s2kpo,
yo, k2tog, yo, k2tog, yo, k, yo, skpo, yo, skpo, yo, (s2kpo OR skpo), *
k, edge st
- row 3: edge st, 2x k,
* 2x (k2tog, yo, k2tog, yo, 3x k, yo, skpo, yo, skpo, k), *
k, edge st
- row 5: edge st, k, k2tog,
*yo, k2tog, yo, 5x k, yo, skpo, yo, s2kpo,
yo, k2tog, yo, 5x k, yo, skpo, yo, (s2kpo OR skpo), *
k, edge st
- row 7: edge st, 2x k,
* 2x (k2tog, yo, 7x k, yo, skpo, k), *
k, edge st
- row 9: edge st, k, k2tog,
*yo, 9x k, yo, s2kpo,
yo, 9x k, yo, (s2kpo OR skpo), *
k, edge st
- row 11: edge st, 2x k,
* 2x (k, yo, 3x k, s2kpo, 3x k, yo, 2x k), *
k, edge st
- row 13: edge st, 2x k,
* 2x (2x k, yo, 2x k, s2kpo, 2x k, yo, 3x k), *
k, edge st
- row 15: edge st, 2x k,
* 2x (3x k, yo, k, s2kpo, k, yo, 4x k), *
k, edge st
- row 17: edge st, 2x k,
* 2x (4x k, yo, s2kpo, yo, 5x k), *
k, edge st
- row 19: edge st, k, k2tog,
* 3x k, yo, 3x k, yo, 3x k, s2kpo,
3x k, yo, 3x k, yo, 3x k, (s2kpo OR skpo), *
k, edge st
